- 4 Any liquid suitable for drinking (8)
- 8 A type of Chinese pastry; one of the most standard pastries in Hong Kong. The bun has either butter cream or whipped cream filling down the middle with coconut sprinkles on the outside. (5,3)
- 10 A container for holding liquids while drinking (5)
- 12 Lamb leg suitable for roasting; a.k.a. gigot (3,2,4)
- 13 A preparation from the seeds of a woody climber of Brazil, used in making an astringent drink (7)
- 14 Food made from dough of flour or meal (5)

- 16 Cooked by frying in fat (5)
- 17 Meat from a domestic hog or pig (4)
- 19 Cut with a hacking tool (4)
- 21 Most highly proteinaceous vegetable crop known (3)
- 22 A kind of delicate forcemeat, commonly poached and used as a dish by itself or for garnishing (8)
- 23 Hardened sugary exudation of various trees (5)
- 24 Drain consisting of a U-shaped section of drainpipe (4)
- 25 Thin-shelled

 - 3 A beverage made by steeping tea leaves in water (3)
 - 4 Leftover cabbage fried with cooked potatoes and sometimes meat (6,3,6)

- produced usually by oxidation of the alcohol in wine or cider (7)
- 6 Sweet liqueur made from wine and brandy flavoured with plum or peach or apricot kernels and bitter almonds (7)
- 7 Mild cream-coloured Dutch cheese shaped in balls (5)
- 9 Cubes of meat marinated and cooked on a skewer (5)
- 10 Lamb leg suitable for roasting (5)
- 11 Very hard unsalted biscuit or bread; a former ship's staple (3,7)
