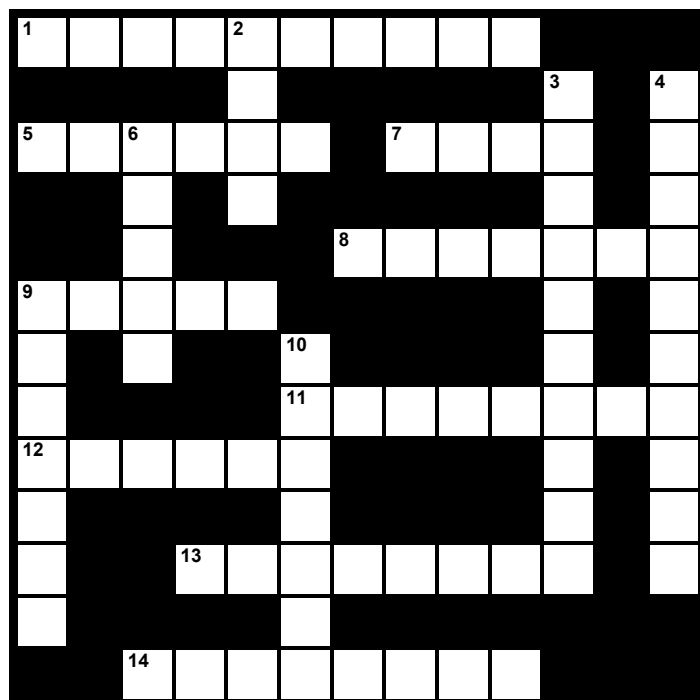

## Across

- 1 Also called biscuits jar. (7,3)
- 5 A small vessel with a perforated top for sprinkling its contents (salt, pepper, etc.). (6)
- 7 Sheet glass cut in shapes for windows or doors. (4)
- 8 A generic term for thin, fine quality glassware made of quartz. (7)
- 9 A small container with a lid, usually for tea. (5)
- 11 A deliberately placed falling drop like inclusion in a piece of glass which is formed by a bubble of air. (8)
- 12 A surface decorated with many small adjoining pieces of coloured stone or glass pieces. (6)
- 13 A method of decorating the rims of bowls and vases in ribbon-like designs. (8)
- 14 General term for all types of decorative glasswares. (3,5)
- 2 Another term for knob. (4)
- 3 Changes on the surface of glass caused by chemical reaction with the environment. (10)
- 4 Decorate an edge with scallops, as of a plate. (10)
- 6 Minute bubbles of gas entrapped in glass body. (5)
- 9 A glass flue surrounding the wick of an oil lamp. (7)
- 10 Process of etching glass surface with the aid of hydrofluoric acid or aqua regia. (7)
