

- 1 An area of sand sloping down to the water of a sea or lake. (5)
- 8 A wide street or thoroughfare. (9)
- 10 Farm consisting of a large tract of land along with facilities needed to raise livestock (especially cattle). (5)
- 12 A wide scenic road planted with trees. (7)
- 13 The visual percept of a region. (5)

- 14 A natural stream of water smaller than a river (and often a tributary of a river). (5)
- 18 A small inlet. (4)
- 19 A major road for any form of motor transport. (7)
- 20 A path or track roughly blazed through wild or hilly country. (5)

Down

- 1 Curved segment (of a road or river or railroad track etc.). (4)
- 2 An addition that extends a main building. (5)
- 3 A place where ships can take on or discharge cargo. (7)
- 4 An open way (generally public) for travel or transportation. (4)
- 5 A road that is raised above water or marshland or sand. (8)
- 6 Extensive tract of level open land. (5)
- 7 Transport from one place to another. (5)
- 9 A wide scenic road planted with trees. (5)
- 11 A strip of land projecting into a body of water. (4)
- 12 A way through or along which someone or something may pass. (7)
- 15 A large natural stream of water (larger than a creek). (5)
- 16 A small natural hill. (5)
- 17 A level tract of land. (4)
