

- 1 A way through or along which someone or something may pass. (7)
- 4 An intermediate platform in a staircase. (7)
- 7 A body of (usually fresh) water surrounded by land. (4)
- 8 An expressway on which tolls are collected. (8)
- 12 A path or track roughly blazed through wild or hilly country. (5)
- 13 A large and imposing house. (7)
- 15 A passageway through or under something, usually underground (especially one for trains or cars). (6)
- 16 A road junction at which traffic streams circularly around a central island. (6)
- 19 A small stream. (3)
- 20 The top point of a mountain or hill. (6)
- 21 (British) street lined with buildings that were originally private stables but have been remodeled as dwellings. (4)
- 23 The place where two or more things come together. (8)
- 25 A place (seaport or airport) where people and merchandise can enter or leave a country. (4)
- 26 A flight maneuver; aircraft flies a complete circle in the vertical plane. (4)



- 27 A downward slope or bend. (4)

- 1 Any area set aside for a particular purpose. (5)
- 2 A facility equipped with special equipment and personnel for a particular purpose. (7)
- 3 (Scottish) a narrow secluded valley (in the mountains). (4)
- 4 Enclosure consisting of a section of canal that can be closed to control the water level; used to raise or lower vessels that pass through it. (4)
- 5 (British) an open river valley (in a hilly area). (4)
- 6 An area of closely cropped grass surrounding the hole on a golf course. (5)
- 9 Relating to or moving along or having the direction of a radius. (6)
- 10 The precise location of something; a spatially limited location. (5)
- 11 An addition that extends a main building. (9)
- 14 A ravine formed by a river in an area with little rainfall. (6)
- 16 A piece of open land for recreational use by the community in an urban area. (6)
- 17 An arrangement of objects or people side by side in a line. (3)
- 18 Extensive landed property (especially in the country) retained by the owner for his own use. (6)
- 19 A part of a river where the current is very fast. (5)
- 22 A sandbank in a stretch of water that is visible at low tide. (5)
- 24 A strip of land projecting into a body of water. (4)
