

- 1 A loose-fitting tunic type garment. (6)
- 3 Small, button-like boss used in conjunction with a ghundi or loop, for fastening. (5)
- 6 A shirt. (5)
- 8 A flared and slightly loose-fitting shirt of knee length and round neck, worn with pajama. Used to be an elegant wear in centers like Lucknow and Hyderabad. (5)

9 Embroidery in white cotton thread upon fine white cotton fabric. (6,4)

10 A blanket or any other warm cloth tied at one end and draped over the head so as to cover the whole body.. (5)

11 Skirt, usually with a great deal of flare, with several triangular gored pieces stitched together. (7)

12 Payjama with a straight cut. (5,7)

14 Pajama with wide legs that trail on the ground, completely

covering the feet; worn often with a kurta. (6,7)

2 A popular textile design consisting of small floral discs or circles. (7,4)

3 Cap. (4)

4 A kind of quilted sleeveless worn over a shirt as outer garment. (6)

5 A moon & star pattern often-used in Indian textile. (5-4)

6 A full-sleeved garment for outer wear, worn by

men; a kind of gown with a long jerkin fastened to it. (4)

7 A coat like garment of knee-length, worn by men close to the body, and opening in front with button-fastenings. (8)

13 A loose outer garment, originated from Arab. (3)
