



## Across

- 2 A persian style jacket or coat meant for outerwear. (Rudik) (5)
- 4 A short breast garment of wide popularity among women in India. (Hiloc) (5)
- 6 A kind of coat of mail. (Hizra) (5)
- 7 Narrow ribbon made of gold or silver thread. (Goat) (4)
- 8 A kurta like garment but shorter in length upto hips, short sleeves and open under the throat. Worn by both men and women. (UR Kit) (5)
- 9 Plain blouse like garment without cups, worn over the breast and held in place with tie-cords tied on the back. (A Ink Jar) (7)
- 12 Payjama with a straight cut. (I Said A Haj Map) (5,7)
- 15 A loose outer garment, originated from Arab. (Baa) (3)
- 18 A full-sleeved garment for outer wear, worn by men; a kind of gown with a long jerkin fastened to it. (Aba Q) (4)
- 19 Cap. (Opti) (4)
- 21 Veil-cloth draped loosely around the upper part of the body, worn by women. (Put Data) (7)
- 23 A Sanskrit word for Short drawers, worn by men and boys. (Haj Gain) (7)
- 24 Literally, "flowered work". Embroidery practiced by women in the Punjab. (Hulk Pair) (8)

- 25 Full-sleeved gown-type outerwear for men, popular at the Mughal and Rajput courts. (Jaam) (4)
  - 26 A kind of pajama for men or a loose outerwear for women. (Zari) (4)
  - 27 A loose-fitting tunic type garment. (Hab Jab) (6)
- Down**
- 1 A men's long-sleeved coat reaching down to the knees, and buttoned in front-middle from neck till waist. (Kancha) (6)
  - 2 A flared and slightly loose-fitting shirt of knee length and round neck, worn with pajama. Used to be an elegant wear in centers like Lucknow and Hyderabad. (A Turk) (5)
  - 3 Unstitched cloth draped over the hips and legs in several ways by both men and women in



- India. (Thodi) (5)
- 4 A moon & star pattern often-used in Indian textile. (A DNA Chart) (5-4)
- 5 A wrapping veil-cloth for a woman, often worn tucked into the side of the waist and drawn upward over the back and the head, the free end being draped over the shoulder. (Had Ion) (6)
- 6 Metallic thread twisted over cotton or silk for brocading. (Riaz) (4)
- 9 A simple choli-blouse is sometimes referred to by this name in Rajasthan and Gujarat. (Auk Pad) (6)
- 10 A sleeveless jacket worn over a shirt or kurta, both by men and women. (Rid As) (5)
- 11 A kind of quilted sleeveless worn over a shirt as outer garment. (Zim Rai) (6)
- 13 Drawstring for tying pajama to waist level. (Brain Adz) (8)
- 14 A popular textile design consisting of small floral discs or circles. (Airbus Faith) (7,4)
- 16 Literally, a plant. A floral motif. (A Tub) (4)
- 17 A small buta commonly used in Indian textile design. (But I) (4)
- 20 Trouser-like garment. A common leg wear in India. (I Am Jaap) (7)
- 22 Turban. (A Grip) (5)
- 23 A blanket or any other warm cloth tied at one end and draped over the head so as to cover the whole body. (Hum JB) (5)
