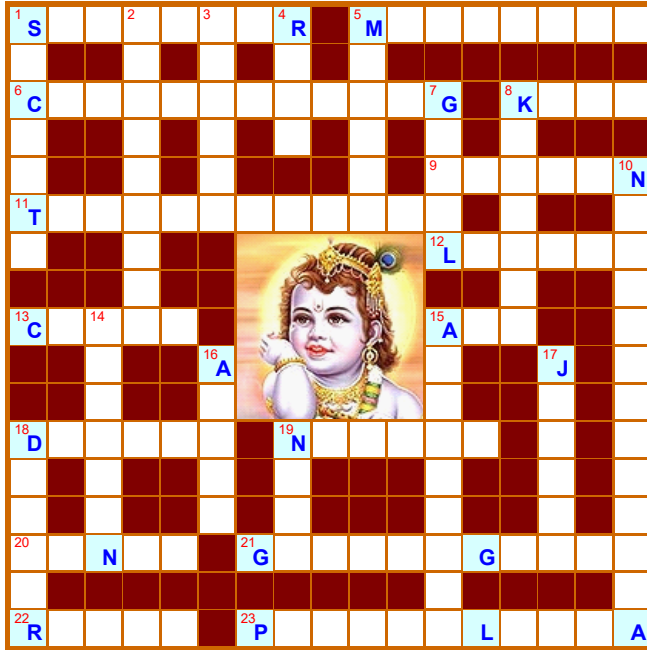

- 6 BHANGCHAPHOP (Hindi word - Lord is fed with the customary prasado of '____', (Fifty six dishes). (8,4)
- 8 Sanskrit word for art form. (4)
- 9 PROSIN (Lord Krishna was born in a ____ in the captivity of King Kansa). (6)
- 11 ADITYAPARTHA (Name of Lord Krishna literally meaning: One whose feet are holy). (12)
- 12 AHORAL (Sanskrit word for Ironsmith). (6)
- 13 ULCER (That's what Kansa was by nature). (5)
- 15 Famous song dedicated to Krishna: "Govinda ____ Re!". (3)
- 18 RAWDAK (A popular city in Gujarat which literally means 'Door to Moksha', i.e. salvation). (6)
- 19 NILRAJ (It involves fasting without having a single drop of water - Hindi word). (6)
- 20 UNPAY (Name of Lord Krishna literally meaning: Meritorious). (5)
- 21 GRAB RIG HA-HA (Lord's idol is kept in Krishna Janma Bhoomi Mandir room also known as the '____'). (6,5)
- 22 A HARD (The most important gopi and closest to Krishna). (5)
- 23 LEAN PLATEAU (Name of the rasleela performed to display the killing of demoness Putana by Krishna). (11)

- 2 A YALTA PIE (Name of Lord Krishna literally meaning: Lord of Earth). (9)

- 5 NO AMAH (Sanskrit word for enchanting and attractive; that's what Lord Krishna is). (6)

- 15 KAY VATAYA (Name of Lord Krishna literally meaning: One who is difficult to comprehend). (9)

- 17 HAJKIN (Hindi word for a tableau depicting a peep into the life of Lord Krishna). (6)
- 18 UPWARD (Lord Krishna was born around 3227 BC, also known as Iron Age, i.e. ____ Yuga) (Hindi word). (6)
