

Leather used on the  
combing rolls of  
cotton machinery and  
manufactured of  
calfskin or side  
leather. (7)
- 9    Leather with a hard  
glossy surface. (6,7)
- 12   Shave, slice or divide  
to peel into a thin  
layer. (5)
- 13   The dressed skin of  
an animal (especially  
a large animal). (4)
- 14   Making leather from  
rawhide. (7)
- 17   A process which  
produces suppleness  
in hides. (7)
- 19   The area of the  
tannery where the  
unhairing and liming  
processes are carried  
out. (9)

- 21   Astringent substances  
of plant origin used in  
tanning leather. (6)
- 22   Process of raising  
fibers on the grain  
side of a hide or skin  
to give a velvet nap  
effect. (7)
- 23   \_\_\_\_\_ leather: Leather  
from which the grain  
is removed by an  
abrasive or bladed  
cylinder. (6)
- 1   Soft full grain  
gloving or clothing  
leather made from  
unsplit sheep or  
lambskin or kid-skin.

- 3   Bark tanned pickled  
sheepskins. (5)
- 4   Measurement of the  
thickness of leather. 1  
\_\_\_\_\_ = 1/64 inch =  
0.4 mm. (5)
- 5   Cutting leather into  
two or more layers  
before tanning. (9)
- 6   Chrome tanned  
leather. (3,4)
- 7   Any process after  
tanning of leather. (6)
- 8   Any component of  
the natural texture of  
the leather. (5)
- 9   Translucent or  
opaque material with  
a smooth surface  
suitable for writing,  
bookbinding and  
other purposes. (9)
- 10   Originally and  
properly calfskin shoe  
leather, dressed with  
birch oil and  
distinguished by its  
odour rather than its  
appearance. (6,7)
- 11   Leather in which the  
grain layer or dermis  
has not been altered.  
(4,5)
- 15   Cattle hide leather  
buffed on the grain  
side to give a velvety  
surface; white or  
coloured. (6)
- 16   Treating by  
incorporating fat. (8)
- 18   A soft suede leather  
formerly from the  
sheep of the chamois  
antelope but now  
from sheepskin. (7)
- 19   An animal belonging  
to the cattle or ox  
family. (6)
- 20   Not reflecting light;  
not glossy. (5)
