

- 2 Also called "cat's tongue" brush. (7)
- 6 Mineral ____ - A refined distillate of petroleum. Also known as "paint thinner." (6)
- 7 Ssolution of resins used to coat paintings for protection and to control gloss. (7)
- 10 A brittle aromatic resin used in varnishes. (5)
- 11 Alter so as to produce a more desirable appearance. (7)
- 13 Flat fan-shaped brush used for blending and special effects. (3)
- 14 A thick oil comprised of linseed, tung, or soya oils which have

been heated to over 300 deg C. (5,3)

- 16 Dry coloring matter (especially an insoluble powder to be mixed with a liquid to produce paint etc). (7)
- 17 An artist's brush made of sable hair. (5)
- 18 Brush with the hair shaped in a round ferrule and coming to a point. Good for general painting and details. (5)

- 1 Alla ____: Technique in which the final surface of a painting is completed in one sitting, without under

painting. (5)

- 3 An implement that has hairs or bristles firmly set into a handle. (5)
- 4 ____ Modernism: Genre of art in reaction against principles and practices of established modernism. (4)

- 5 Good for thin paint and applying glazes and very useful in a filberts shape. (8)
- 8 That which promotes drying. (9)

12 An upright tripod for displaying something (usually an artist's canvas). (5)

- 13 Brush with a flat endge. Used for general painting. (4)
- 15 Any of various hard resins from fir trees. (5)
