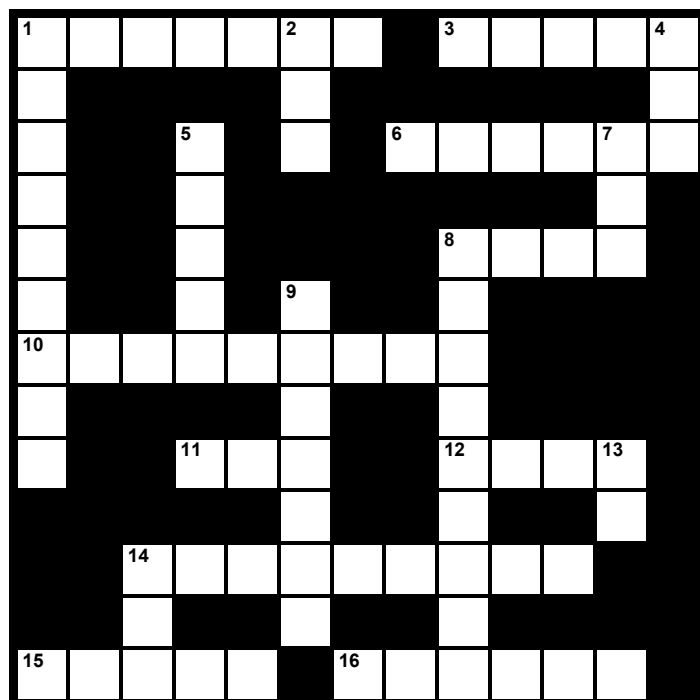

- 1 A paste-up made by sticking together pieces of paper or photographs. (7)
- 3 Medium for written communication. (5)
- 6 A solution added to paper to make it less absorbent. (6)
- 8 A mixture of cellulose fibers. (4)
- 10 Writing paper having a watermark of fine lines running across the grain. (4,5)
- 11 A Japanese word for "paper." (3)
- 12 A coarse bushy annual with

- palmate leaves and clusters of small green flowers; yields tough fibers and narcotic drugs. (4)
- 14 A paper with little or no sizing. Very absorbent. (9)
- 15 The slender, thread-like cellulose structures that cohere to form a sheet of paper. (5)
- 16 The purest form of cellulose produced in nature. (6)

- 1 A paper collage process in which sheets of paper are laminated together

- by the pressure of the etching press and glue. (4,5)
- 2 The gram weight of one square meter of paper. Also called grammage. (3)
- 4 Formerly the principal raw material used in the making process. (3)
- 5 A flat screen with wire mesh onto which the deckle is placed during hand paper making. (5)
- 7 A soft or fuzzy surface texture of some writing surfaces. (3)

- 8 A superior paper resembling sheepskin. (9)
- 9 An instrument for measuring thickness between two points. (7)
- 13 It stands for potential of Hydrogen. (2)
- 14 The continuous ribbon of paper, in its full width, during any stage of its progress through the paper machine. (3)
