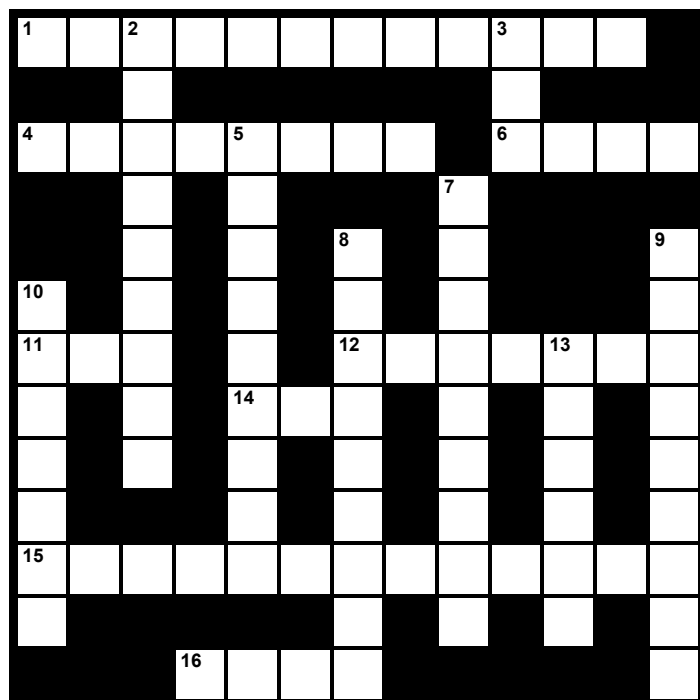

- 11 A Bill that has been passed by Parliament, received President's assent, and become law. (3)
- 12 The room in which the Legislative Council or the Legislative Assembly meets. (7)
- 14 Member of the Legislative Assembly. (3)
- 15 The list of people who are enrolled to vote. (9,4)
- 16 A proposed law, statute, or legislation that is introduced into Parliament but has

not yet been passed. (4)

- 2 A group of MPs that considers matters referred to it and reports its findings to Parliament. (9)
- 3 The system of rules providing a basis for society to function harmoniously and efficiently. (3)
- 5 An alteration to a Bill or Act. (9)

- 7 Document prepared by Parliamentary Counsel for use by Cabinet in discussing proposed legislation. (5,4)
- 8 A Parliament that has two Houses (an Upper House and a Lower House). (9)

- 10 Persons appointed by a head of state to head executive departments of government and act as official advisers. (7)
