

Across

- 1 A large smooth mass of rock detached from its place of origin. (7)
- 3 A fertile tract in a desert (where the water table approaches the surface). (5)
- 5 A deep ravine (usually with a river running through it). (5)
- 7 Wetland having visible standing water and dominated by trees. (5)

9 A barrier across a river intended to control the flow of water. (7)

12 Complement of gases that surround the earth. (10)

14 A curve in a stream of water. (7)

16 A desert lake, dry most of the time, and marked by white salt crusts. (5)

17 Extensive tract of level open land. (5)

18 A long depression in the surface of the land that usually contains a river. (6)

19 A barrier

constructed to contain the flow of water. (3)

Down

1 Wet spongy ground of decomposing vegetation. (3)

2 Artificial lake created by building a dam across a river. (9)

4 Average level of the world's oceans. (3,5)

6 A drowned river valley in an area of rolling coastal hills. (3)

8 Severe weather with heavy rain and strong winds. (5)

10 A natural stream of water smaller than a river (and often a tributary of a river). (5)

11 Water falling in drops from vapour condensed in the atmosphere. (8)

13 A relatively flat highland. (7)

15 A loose material consisting of grains of rock or coral. (4)
