

- 3 Plumb line for determining depth (8)
- 6 A division of an ocean (3)
- 7 A low triangular area where a river divides before entering a larger body of water (5)
- 9 A linear unit of measurement (equal to 6 feet) for water depth (6)
- 11 Lacking physical depth (7)
- 13 A small channel (as one formed by soil erosion) (4)
- 15 Of or relating to clay, silt or gravel (8)
- 16 The outlet of a river or drain or other source of water (7)
- 18 Long and narrow strip of water made for boats or for irrigation (5)
- 19 The part of the seashore between the high-water mark and the low-water mark (9)
- 20 A stretch of turbulent water in a river or the sea caused by one current flowing into or across another current (3)
