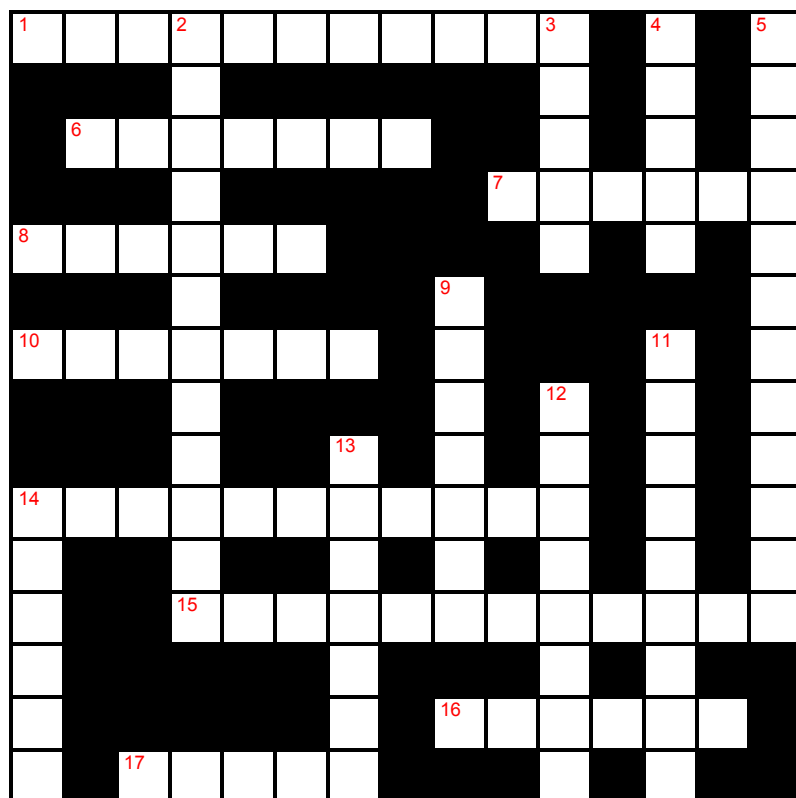

- 7 Capital of the state of Montana; located in western Montana. (6)
- 8 State capital of New York; located in eastern New York State on the west bank of the Hudson river. (6)
- 10 State capital and largest city of Georgia; chief commercial center of

the southeastern United States. (7)

- 14 Capital of the state of Florida; located in northern Florida. (11)
- 15 The capital and largest city of Utah; located near the Great Salt Lake in north central Utah; world capital of the Mormon Church. (4,4,4)
- 16 The state capital and largest city of Colorado; located in central Colorado on the South Platte river. (6)
- 17 The capital and largest city of Idaho. (5)

- 2 The capital and largest city of Indiana; a major commerical center in the country's heartland; site of an annual 500-mile automobile race. (12)
- 3 The capital of the state of Delaware. (5)
- 4 Capital of the state of Oregon in the northwestern part of the state on the Willamette River. (5)
- 5 Capital and largest city of Oklahoma; the economy is based on oil and livestock. (8,4)
- 9 The capital of the state of Maine. (7)

- 11 The capital and largest city in Iowa. (3,6)
- 12 The capital and largest city of Wyoming; located in the southeastern corner of the state. (8)
- 13 Capital of the state of New Mexico; located in north central New Mexico. (5,2)
- 14 The capital of the state of Kansas; located in eastern Kansas on the Kansas river. (6)
