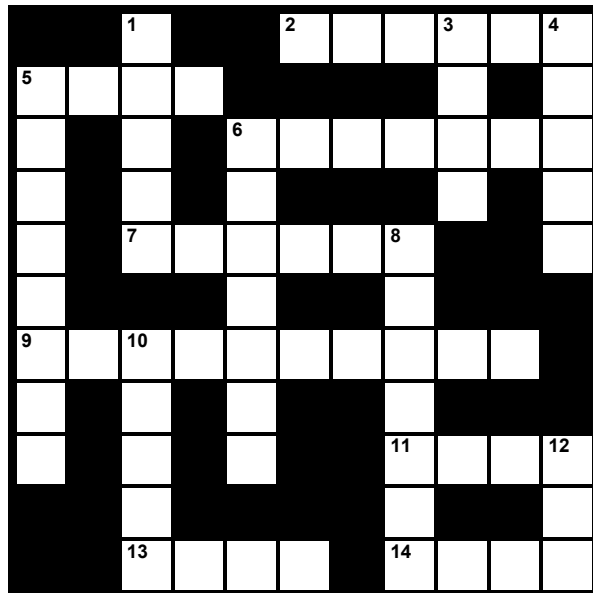

## Across

- 2 An edge tool with a flat steel blade with a cutting edge. (6)
- 5 A short wire permanently attached to a receptacle or switch. (4)
- 6 An electrical device that provides a path for electrical current to flow. (7)
- 7 Control consisting of a mechanical or electrical or electronic device for making or breaking or changing the connections in a circuit. (6)
- 9 An electrical (or electronic) fitting that is connected to

- a source of power and equipped to receive an insert. Commonly referred to as plugs, outlets or sockets. (10)
- 11 A framework that holds the panes of a window in the window frame. (4)
- 13 A notch, channel, or slit made in any material by cutting or sawing. (4)
- 14 A unit of power equal to 1 joule per second; the power dissipated by a current of 1 ampere flowing across a resistance of 1 ohm. (4)

## Down

- 1 The overhang at the lower edge of a roof. (5)
- 3 A vertical support piece in a framed wall. (4)
- 4 Catch for fastening a door or gate; a bar that can be lowered or slid into a groove. (5)
- 5 A heavy woodscrew with a square or hexagonal head that is driven in with a wrench. (3,5)
- 6 A mechanical device consisting of a cylindrical tube around which the wire is wound to curl it. (7)
- 8 Saw used with one hand for cutting metal. (7)
- 10 A holding device consisting of adjustable jaws that center a workpiece in a lathe or center a tool in a drill. (5)
- 12 Electrically charged. (3)
