

- 1 Last name of John Quincy, the 6th President of the United States and son of the 2nd President (1767-1848). (5)
- 3 First name of Cleveland, the 22nd and 24th President of the United States (1837-1908). (6)
- 6 First name of S. Truman, Elected Vice President in Roosevelt's 4th term; who became 33rd President of the United States on Roosevelt's death in 1945 and was elected President in 1948; authorized the use of atomic bombs against Japan (1884-1972). (5)
- 7 Last name of John, the Elected Vice President and became the 10th President of the United States when Harrison died (1790-1862). (5)
- 8 Last name of George, the 1st President of the United States. (10)
- 12 Middle name of Herbert Hoover, the 31st President of the United States; in 1929 the stock market crashed and the economy collapsed and Hoover was defeated for re-election by Franklin Roosevelt (1874-1964). (5)
- 14 First name of Clark Hoover, the 31st President of the United States; in 1929 the stock market crashed and the economy collapsed and Hoover was defeated for re-election by Franklin Roosevelt (1874-1964). (7)
- 16 Last name of Martin Van, the 8th President of the United States (1782-1862). (5)
- 17 Last name of John, the 4th President of the United States; member of the Constitutional Congress and recorder at the Constitutional Convention in 1776; helped frame the Bill of Rights (1751-1836). (7)

- 2 First name of Jackson, the 7th president of the US; successfully defended New Orleans from the British in 1815; expanded the power of the presidency (1767-1845). (6)
- 3 Middle name of Warren Harding, the 29th President of the United States; two of his appointees were involved in the Teapot Dome scandal (1865-1823). (8)
- 4 Middle name of James Carter, the 39th President of the United States (1924-). (4)
- 5 Last name of Gerald Rudolph, the 38th President of the United States; appointed Vice President and succeeded Nixon when Nixon resigned (1913-). (4)
- 9 Last name of James, the 20th President of the United States; assassinated by a frustrated office-seeker (1831-1881). (8)
- 10 Last name of Richard Milhous, Vice President under Eisenhower and 37th President of the United States; who resigned after the Watergate scandal in 1974 (1913-1994). (5)
- 11 Middle name of Richard Nixon, Vice President under Eisenhower and 37th President of the United States; who resigned after the Watergate scandal in 1974 (1913-1994). (7)
- 13 First name of Adams, the 2nd President of the United States (1735-1826). (4)
- 15 Middle name of Martin Buren, the 8th President of the United States (1782-1862). (3)
