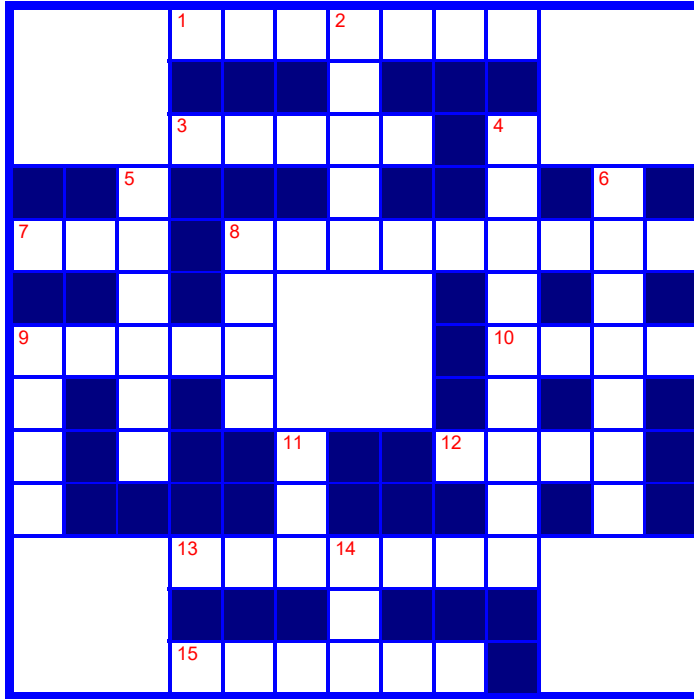


## Ganesh\_Chaturthi\_Festival-of-India
