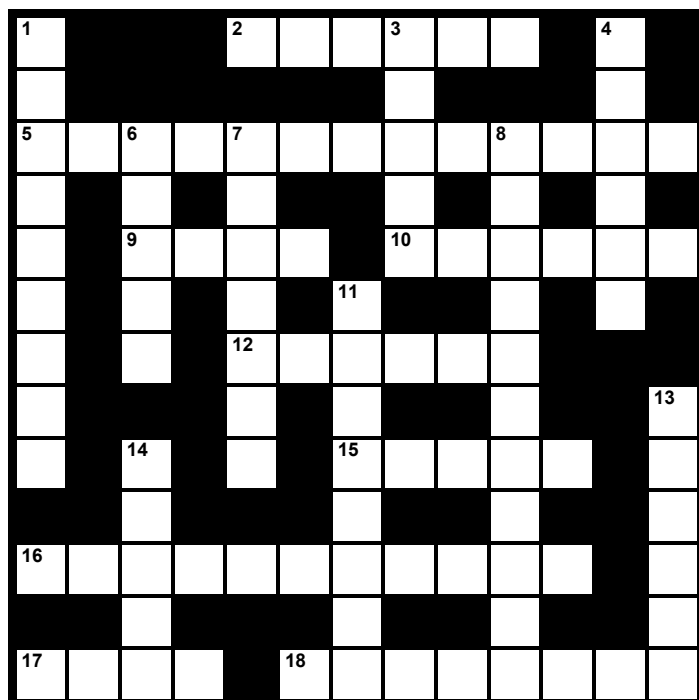

## Across

- 2 Any of the membranous air-filled extensions of the lungs of birds. (6)
- 5 Either of a pair of tubes conducting the egg from the ovary to the uterus. (9,4)
- 9 A taxonomic group that is a division of a species. (4)
- 10 In a condition of biological rest or suspended animation. (6)
- 12 Growth of hair or wool or fur covering the body of an animal. (6)

- 15 Large bony or horny plate as on an armadillo or turtle. (5)
- 16 A hierarchy of food chains with the principle predator at the top; each level preys on the level below (4,7)
- 17 Animal hunted or caught for food. (4)
- 18 Any of a number of hoofed mammals superficially similar but not necessarily closely related taxonomically. (8)

- 1 The faculty of smell. (9)
- 3 The hollow axial stem of a feather. (5)
- 4 Offspring produced by breeding animals of different varieties or breeds or species. (6)
- 6 The immature free-living form of most invertebrates and amphibians and fish which at hatching from the egg is fundamentally unlike its parent and must metamorphose. (5)

- 7 Back part of the head or skull. (7)
- 8 Operating or living or growing on land. (11)
- 11 The ventral shield or shell of tortoises and turtles. (8)
- 13 Flightless birds having flat breastbones lacking a keel for attachment of flight muscles: ostriches; cassowaries; emus; moas; rheas; kiwis; elephant birds. (6)
- 14 A land ecosystem with distinct plant life; e.g., wetland, grassland, rain forest. (5)
