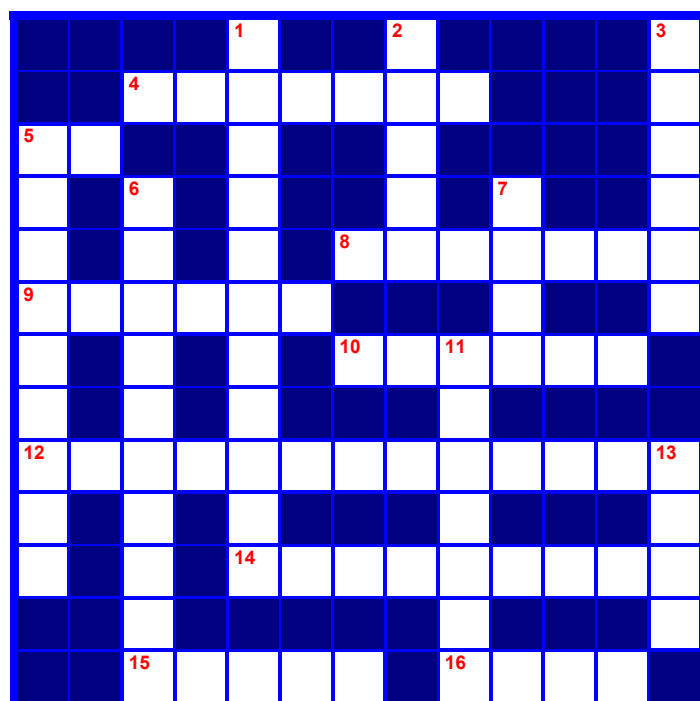

- 10 A device to warm the aquarium water. (6)
- 12 Chemicals, just like vitamins, needed to be replenished in small amounts for aquarium creatures to

survive. (5,8)

- 14 Added to water in the form of chloride ( $\text{SrCl}_2$ ) and is necessary for the growth of calcareous skeletons. (9)
- 15 Acronym for reduction-oxidation potential. (5)

- 13 A receptacle that is placed under the main aquarium, to increase the system's total water volume, and to place various pieces of hardware, like pumps, heaters, reactors, probes, etc. (4)
