

1 Plant-like chlorophyll-containing aquatic organisms lacking true stems and roots and leaves. (5)

2 A gas, which is used as a sterilizing agent to kill bacteria and small organisms in the water. (5)

3 Fairy shrimp; brine shrimp. (7)

4 Slightly salty water. (8)

6 Partially carbonized vegetable matter saturated with water; can be used as a filter material to soften water and make it more acidic. (4)
